Recording Options: Mono

- Soundcard input and Built-in microphone
- iMic USB interface and SmartMusic microphone
- Blue Snowball USB microphone
- Audio interface (M-Audio Fast Track) and Pro microphone (SM58)



Recording Options: Stereo

- Stereo Audio Interface
 - M-Audio Fast Track Pro
- Handheld recorder
 - Zoom H4N
- Mixer for multi-mic setup
 - Mackie 1202-VLZ3



Some Audacity Functions

- Record audio
- Multi-track
- Normalize
- Fade in/out
- Add effects (EQ, reverb, etc)
- Cut, Cpy, Paste
- Import CD tracks
- Import audio files (MP3, AIFF, WAV, etc)
- Change pitch
- Change duration
- Stereo Recording
- Mono Recording
- Layer-in Parts
