- Solo various combinations of drum tracks
 - □ Ex. Kick/snare #3 with hi-hat/ride #2
- Change drum combinations every 4 bars

Chord Progression



- White keys only
- 3 chord shapes derived from inversions.
 - □ Root (R): OxOxO
 - □ 1st Inversion (1): 0x0xx0
 - □ 2nd Inversion (2): OxxOxO
- All shapes can be played on any white key note
- Identify the chord by the lowest note and the shape (R, 1, or 2)
- To create a chord progress, draw 4 blanks on their paper and choose a note and a shape for each blank.



Chord Progression

Bass Line

- Figure out the bass line based on the root of the chord shapes
 - ☐ R: bottom note
 - ☐ 1: top note
 - □ 2: middle note
- Play 1 note pitch per bar
- Add some sort of rhythmic feel and consider changing the rhythm every 4 bars.





Bass Line



Sequenced Melody

- Set right hand in 5finger position
- Compose a 5-note melodic pattern
 - □ Ex. 1 3 4 5 1
- Sequence this pattern to the keys of the bass line.
